



INJURY MANAGEMENT POLICY (REHABILITATION)

Corke has in place systems and procedures aimed at the prevention of workplace injury. Should a workplace injury occur, the company will provide injury management services that:

- Support an injured employee from the time of their injury until a sustainable return to work is achieved.
- Ensure ongoing compliance with State and Federal legislation.
- Minimise the impact of injury on our operations.

The organisation will:

- Provide employee training on injury management and improve awareness of its objectives throughout the company.
- Ensure that injury management processes commence immediately following an injury.
- Consult with injured employees, their representatives, treating doctors, our insurers, rehabilitation providers and other related medical/health services to effect a sustainable return to work.
- Provide suitable duties to all injured employees to achieve a sustainable return to work.
- Ensure injured employees are treated fairly during their participation in injury management processes.
- Ensure the performance of our workers compensation insurers, medical, rehabilitation and related service providers, through ongoing review.

Corke recognises the mutual benefit gained by the company and its employees through fulfilling the above commitments, and encourages active co-operation from all employees.
